Hello Harmony United Church Members,

It is that time of year again! As you might know from the church announcements, our annual Blueberry Sale will be held on Saturday, July 18th. This newsletter's intent is to provide you with the details of how the sale will run this year.

Last year the sale generated over \$7,400.00 in profit. This was thanks to the strong support of our community of faith, publicizing the event and encouraging sales either online or by ticket sales through the office. We are anticipating your valued support again this year. The good news is the berries are delicious. The not so good news is our costs have increased and we have had to pass that on to the buyer. **A full flat is \$43.00 (12 pints), a half flat is \$28.00 (6 pints) and a quarter flat is \$16.00 (3 pints).**

The preferred method of ordering is online. The online order form can be found at this [LINK](#). Fill in the online order, pay by e-transfer, and enter the word blueberry in the e-transfer message box. If you do not wish to e-transfer, fill out the form online and choose the option to pay by cheque or cash (exact amount). Payment must be brought in to the office at 177 Sunset Drive from **Tuesday to Friday between 10:00 and 12:00** on or before July 7th. If you do not want to order online, tickets are available through the church office at the times listed above. Payment would be by cheque or exact cash. **All payments by cheque are payable to Harmony United Church.** Proceeds from the sale of the blueberries will again be used to help support social justice and food security programs in Regina.

Blueberry Pick up day is Saturday July 18th (from 9 – 2).

It will be the same format as previous years with a drive through pickup in the parking lot of the Montessori School at 3913 Hillsdale St. Customers are asked to stay in their vehicles while the blueberries are placed in their trunk. There will also be a limited number of **blueberry crisps** available for purchase the day of sale. There is **no pre-order** for these. **Regular crisps** will be **\$19.00** and **gluten free crisps** will be **\$21.00 cash only**.

It would be greatly appreciated, if you feel comfortable, to put up the attached poster at your workplace or another location. For the members who have a Facebook account it would be super if you would 'share' our poster. Also, please consider posting the sale on your intranet within your workplace.
